Mark synthesized 30 years of research and experience in civic activism and urban design into a model neighborhood that encourages and supports the innovative independent spirit of Santa Cruz.

The Delaware Addition may point the way to our next economy, one where people live and work within resilient communities free from automobile dependence. It's about sustainability, not gentrification, where 350 people live and 500 people work on 20 acres. You can own 600 square feet, 40,000 square feet or anything in between. The first of 40 buildings are scheduled to break ground this year.
